Meeting Minutes

1. WELCOME, CALL TO ORDER

2. DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL OF PAST MONTH'S MEETING MINUTES – approved with a correction to first bullet Update, correction in red font in the minutes.

3. FINANCIAL REPORT – current balance \$10,345.59, no bills pending and an invoice was resent to Northern Water as requested.

4. CDSN CONTRACTOR (LYNN) OR UPDATE FROM PRESIDENT – No update.

5. UPDATES

- City of Fort Collins would like to meet to discuss CDSN and donations. Casey sent letter for possible contribution. – **Locating a contact for the Lower Poudre River Monitoring Alliance.**
- Jordan will be developing a fact sheet on how to retrieve data from CDSN for SPRUWP's Science & Data Sub-Committee. Diane wondered if a CWA workshop would be good for SPRUWP and Jordan agreed to check with that group for interest in a data literacy workshop. Jordan has completed a "Quick Start Guide" for the CDSN data tools (Google-Mapper, AWQMS, Web GIS) for first time users. Continue work on this after CDSN updates are completed. Provide the group a presentation to show that working in the CDSN is not cumbersome. – **Draft is developed.**
- Ongoing interest and discussion are currently taking place for the follow-up Data Literacy for the Purgatory Watershed group in Trinidad. – **No new information.**
- One Water Solutions Institute new Hydrologic & Water Quality Assessment tool is now available at onewatersolutions.com. – **QA/QC being conducted with CDPHE, plus One Water Solutions Institute has new website information for documentation.**
- Problem with the CWQMC and CDSN webpage links when queried on internet. Some links go to CWA or CMF. Tyler suggested that closing the CWQMC webpage could resolve the problem. Has the webpage been shut down yet? – **No update.**

- We had calls that were dropped off during last month’s conference call. Discussion on frequency of dropped calls that may require action. – Still working on this, Bob’s call was dropped after being on the call for 30-minutes during this conference call.
- Regulation 93 Rulemaking Hearing emphasized the need for the Division to receive data during the data call, instead of after the listing analyses are completed. The Division is planning on addressing this aspect. How could/should we assist them? – No update on the idea of a flowchart.
- CDSN webpage update status. – No update.

6. NEW BUSINESS

- Casey and Tyler will work on 2020 Data Literacy event for the North Front range Planning Committee.
- Bent County Conservation District invited us to their March 4, 2020 annual meeting, interested in Data Literacy.
