- City of Fort Collins would like to meet to discuss CDSN and donations. – Perhaps contacts can be determined during the Poudre River Forum on Feb. 28th.
- Problem with the CWQMC and CDSN webpage links when queried on internet. Some links go to CWA or CMF. Tyler suggested that closing the CWQMC webpage could resolve the problem. Has the webpage been shut down yet? We had calls that were dropped off during last month's conference call. – It has been corrected.
- Discussion on frequency of dropped calls that may require action. – Appeared to be corrected until Casey had trouble calling in, we'll continue to note any future problems.
- Regulation 93 Rulemaking Hearing emphasized the need for the Division to receive data during the data call, instead of after the listing analyses are completed. The Division is planning on addressing this aspect. How could/should we assist them, with a flowchart? - Linda and Jordan will develop a draft for the group to review.
- CDSN webpage update status. – See contractor update above.
- Data Literacy updates. – Data Literacy has become very popular due to mainly the team's charismatic personalities and enthusiasm for data information sharing. Tyler and Tammi are developing a story board for the Poudre River Forum with potential to be used during other data Literacy presentations. Jordan

- Upper South Platte Watershed group has undergone membership changes. Casey will contact Douglas County (a current member) to gage interest in scheduling a Data Literacy presentation.
