4. CDSN CONTRACTOR OR UPDATE FROM PRESIDENT – No report from contractor and president had last minute field work call. Jordan had a discussion with contractor, get Reg. 85 data to Contractor by Feb. 15th, contractor has checked with CDPHE Environmental Data Unit with questions on this year's Reg. 85 with no answer as of yet. There may be possible lab data delivery conflicts due to COVID.

5. UPDATES

- Our first virtual Teams meeting. Does it work well for everyone? - Sound is better and video aids with conversation. Keep using it. Agenda links were good. CWA has some conflict with time due to other meetings through spring.
- CDSN data providers conversation/survey update. The goal for the survey is to address any problems data providers may experience with the CDSN; things they like, updates or expansions, and how best to support the CDSN. Bob recently sent out examples of former surveys for thoughts for the new survey. Still time to add your comments to Bob's example or your own unique survey questions. If CWA grant funds are used on survey will certain aspects need to be addressed, ~~to~~ meet CWA grant funding? Perhaps a good idea to plan a workshop or something similar after survey for follow-up? How can the survey build upon the SPCURE work started from 2019 Confluence at the Confluence on data needs? Will our Project Coordinator or CWA be able to assist with sending the survey and replies to the survey? - Suggestion made for a small committee to lead with the survey develop survey with a delayed start in spring after the Reg. 85 data call. Jordan volunteered to lead the committee and welcomes your assistance with this work.
- Future strategy to assess how best to get out in front of groups with CDSN information and what type of information to generate for those presentations and for engaging the public. - Our partners (Colorado Watershed Assembly and One Water Solutions Institute) have done so much discussion on the value of the

CDSN with meetings with other groups and through Data Literacy that we are much grateful for their work, thank you! We still look for avenues for how our small group of active CDSN members can participate. – [Casey suggested that a sub-committee to look at this issue.](#)
