4. CDSN PROJECT COORDINATOR REPORT (Lynn)

- Update on our involvement with the National Water Quality Monitoring (NWQMC) Conference in Denver, March 25-29, 2019. Jordan has submitted our abstract for a presentation and he should be notified by January. At this time the council will have Bob McDade attending the conference and possibly Jordan, Linda, and Casey. Do we want to pursue a presentation for the conference?
In addition, Tim Steele has also submitted two abstracts for the conference and waiting to hear if accepted.

- The NWQMC Conference Planning Committee briefly discussed opportunities for local watershed group participation at the NWCMC on our last call. A couple thing to pass on:
 - EPA typically provides a booth for volunteer monitoring groups at the conference. I'm not sure what they would like to present, but this might fit their needs
 - We will be looking for volunteers to help with a number of tasks during the conference and will put out a call for volunteers around Jan/Feb.
 - Informed by Barb Horn that NWQMC should be sending out information if our abstract was accepted by December 1st.
 - Casey and Bob are working with Colorado Monitoring Framework to schedule the meeting we have been discussing during previous conference calls to proceed with that partnership potential.
