1. **WELCOME, CALL TO ORDER -** Joining the call: Bob McDade, Casey Davenhill, Jordan Parman, Diane Kielty, Sarah Reeves, Lisa Hollander, and Linda Chynoweth
2. **APPROVAL OF PAST MONTH'S MEETING MINUTES -** Approved
3. **FINANCIAL REPORT**

4. **CDSN PROJECT COORDINATOR REPORT (Lynn) –** Update from Bob. Bob will contact Lynn and have her update CDSN webpage in January with latest 303(d) listed streams, check links within the webpage (Barb discovered some that were broken) and add 2018 data call information (Reg. 85 and WQCD basin data call). Discussion on possibility of paying for Lynn to attend NWQMC conference in Denver in March, tabled until next conference call.
5. **UPDATES**
 - Sarah and Lisa discussed Colorado Monitoring Framework and asked questions on CWQMC focus with discussion toward working on a partnership with the two groups. This conversation will continue with next meeting to be scheduled as an in-person meeting.
 - Update on our involvement with the National Water Quality Monitoring (NWQMC) Conference in Denver, March 25-29, 2019. Jordan has not received word from NWQMC on his CDSN presentation. Anticipate an answer in January, his presentation on Metro's work has been accepted. Jordan received word on Christmas eve that his CDSN presentation was not accepted.
 - The NWQMC Conference Planning Committee briefly discussed opportunities for local watershed group participation at the NWQMC on our last call. Jordan volunteered to follow-up on a table or booth for the CDSN poster presentation.
6. **NEW BUSINESS –** Aimee Konowal, WQCD, was contacted by Linda that the WQCD Nutrient webpage does not include language that dischargers can submit their Reg. 85 data through CDSN or another comparable public

database. She appreciated that they had overlooked that information and would add it with their some webpage update.
