1. WELCOME, CALL TO ORDER - Joining the call: Bob McDade (CDOT), Jordan Parman (MWRD), Diane Kielty (CWA), Mallory Hiss (CWA), Lynn Padgett (CDSN Contractor) and Linda Chynoweth (Aurora Water).

2. APPROVAL OF PAST MONTH'S MEETING MINUTES – Approved with Lynn's noted correction on the webpage updates. The webpage GIS update is not with vectors. Revised version replaced in CWQMC webpage.

3. FINANCIAL REPORT

4. CDSN Contractor (Lynn) or update from President – Lynn discussed progress on data call for Reg. 85 and Reg. 38/93. Division is no longer concerned with data set duplications with data calls which makes data calls easier for Lynn to compile for the Division. Lynn has received about half of the regular Reg. 85 data provider's data at this time, with notice from the anticipated group of Reg. 85 data providers stating they will use CDSN again this year. SunCor is a new Reg. 85 data providers this year to upload data into the CDSN. Just a few correspondence from data providers with data pertaining to Reg. 38 have stated submit their data to the Division's data call. Lynn will follow-up to data providers unheard from to tailor the data call to their needs. Lynn provided a link to the test CDSN webpage she is developing to receive feedback. Plan is to go live with new webpage soon (end of February or first of March) in order to get the much used data call information out to the public. Please provide Lynn any comments as soon as possible. The new webpage is built upon DreamWeaver platform.

5. UPDATES

- Webpage updates, where Lynn is with the process. **Lynn is working on updating CDSN website. She is also processing the Data Call from the Division on Reg 38 & 93.** Lynn and Bob are working with OWSI to get to get webpage links in theirs and ours webpages. More webpage information in above Contractor update.
- In person meeting to be scheduled with Colorado Monitoring Framework. No update at this time.
- Update on our involvement with the National Water Quality Monitoring (NWQMC) Conference in Denver, March 25-29, 2019. **Appears to be a go since there was not a recent second Federal shutdown.**
- Data Literacy Workshop in Trinidad Planned for February 22, 2019, 9:00-12:30 with approximately 60-80 people.

- Tim Steele was requesting some support from CWQMC for the attendance of fee cost for the NWQMC Conference. He will be attending the conference for one day and giving a presentation which includes how they used CDSN data information. Tim also has offered to market the CDSN Data System during the conference. **Update: Casey chatted with Dave Holm with Clear Creek Group and he agreed to cover half the cost for Tim to Attend. Tim will register himself and send Casey the invoice. Then Casey will reimburse Tim and bill Dave at Clear Creek for half (\$107.50).**

6. NEW BUSINESS

- Need to discuss updating or moving the CWQMC website information to CDSN. **Everyone is in agreement to move the information on CWQMC to the CDSN webpage and eliminate the CWQMC webpage. Process for how this will be done will continue with emails as necessary.**
- MtnGeoGeek (Lynn) Annual Contract. Lynn has requested to be referred going forward as CDSN Contractor. **Done**
- The council has to develop a renewal process so every October will start the contract talks and be completed by December each year for MtnGeoGeek Annual contract. **Agreed with how best to accomplish this timeframe prior to the end of this year.**
- 2019 CWQMC/CDSN contributions. **Bob will work with Casey on the 2019 list and Linda will assist with sending out the requests for support. Contributions are the major support of the CDSN, along with fee-for-service for CDSN data provider needs as the only other financial support of the CDSN. These finances are used to pay Gold Systems for AWQMS (CDSN web-based data management system), ESRI (GIS tools) and our Contractor fees. Thank you to everyone who supported the CDSN in 2018! We look forward to assisting you with your data needs in 2019.**
